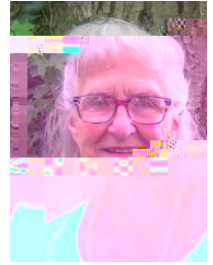


_____ 's name was misspelled in last week's newsletter. It has been corrected in the [Archives](#).
