The Family Educationa Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA) Isoknown as the Buckley Amendment is a federal law that protects the privacy of student "educational ecords."

"Educational records" are defined, with a few exceptions as records containing information directly related to a student that are maintained by a school or its agent (including electronic records). In higher education, FERPA prohibits schools from d i9ng
