Toastmasters International District 7, with support of the Oregon State Sententiary's Administration, will facilitate a four hour Community Safety Conference hosted at OSJ on Friday, April 12, 2024, from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM. The conference will be comprised of up to 100 individuals representing a cross-section of key leaders in the community. These include social service agencies, victim advocates, religious representatives, lawmakers, academia, youth authority administrators, criminal justice professionals, community peace activists and transformed offenders residing inside and outside of prison. We believe that although many stakeholders impacted by crime hold a multitude of different political views and philosophies, We All Have a Stake in Healing.

This conference will be a monumental step in the way in which we, as Oregonians, look at addressing crime in the State of Oregon.

Conference Objectives

Develop working relationships between community leaders and the community to reduce the nature and number of crimes and violence

Increase access to Restorative and Transformative Justice programming and establish Restorative and Transformative Justice principles in all Oregon prisons

Increase access to peer mentors and credible messengers

Enhance the awareness of the circumstances by which crimes occur by identifying behaviors and attitudes that predispose individuals to commit criminal acts

Develop prevention/intervention treatment and training strategies aimed at reducing youth crime and violence

Explore and develop meaningful ways in which transformed individuals can make meaningful contributions to the outside community
